**Definition:** Major diagnostic categories (MDCs) are 23 mutually exclusive categories into

which all possible principal diagnoses fall. The diagnoses in each category correspond to a single body system or aetiology, broadly reflecting the speciality providing care. Each category is partitioned according to whether or not a surgical procedure was performed. This preliminary partitioning into major diagnostic

categories occurs before a diagnosis related group is assigned.

The Australian refined diagnosis related groups (AR-DRGs) departs from the use of principal diagnosis as the initial variable in the assignment of some groups. A hierarchy of all exceptions to the principal diagnosis-based assignment to a MDC has been created. As a consequence, certain AR-DRGs are not unique to a MDC.

This requires both a MDC and an AR-DRG to be generated per patient.

**Context:** All admitted patient care contexts:

The generation of a major diagnostic category to accompany each AR-DRG is a

requirement of the latter as diagnosis related groups are not unique.
