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# **Dwelling—modification requirement status**

## Identifying and definitional attributes

Metadata item type:	Data Element Concept
METEOR identifier:	269583
Registration status:	Housing assistance, Retired 10/02/2006
Definition:	Whether anyone in a household requires modifications to the dwelling because of a <u>disability</u> or health condition.
Context:	Useful in determining need for provision of modified dwellings. Such dwellings may be difficult to find in the private rental market.

# **Object Class attributes**

## Identifying and definitional attributes

Object class:	Dwelling
Definition:	A structure or a discrete space within a structure intended for people to live in or where a person or group of people live. Thus a structure that people actually live in is a dwelling regardless of its intended purpose, but a vacant structure is only a dwelling if intended for human residence. A dwelling may include one or more rooms used as an office or workshop provided the dwelling is in residential use.
Context:	Dwellings are the main counting unit in the housing sector. Dwellings are reported for a variety of purposes including number of untenantable or tenantable, and occupied or vacant dwellings. Dwellings may be owned and/or, managed, and/or available for a use by a specific program, including head-leased stock from <u>private</u> and <u>government</u> sources. A dwelling includes a <u>boarding house building</u> and <u>boarding house units</u> .
Specialisation of:	Environmental factors

#### **Collection and usage attributes**

Guide for use: Boarding house rooms or beds are not identified as separate dwellings unless they are self-contained. Self-contained rooms are therefore defined as units and are counted as a separate dwelling.

For the public rental housing and state owned and managed Indigenous housing data collections, the number of tenancy (rental) units is used as a proxy for counting the number of dwellings.
