Code 2 Name not for continued use: Includes certain tribal names which may not be appropriate for long term use. Code 3 Special Privacy/Security Requirements: May apply to names for which episodes are attached that should only be accessible to specified authorised persons. There must be a specific need to implement this additional security level. Local policy should provide guidance to the use of this code.
