Definition: A measure of the level of incontinence of a nursing home resident in terms of the frequency with which the resident is incontinent at admission to residential accommodation.

Context: Nursing home statistics: along with functional profile, specialised nursing procedures and behaviour, continence constitutes one of the key indicators of dependency and disability for nursing home residents and serves to supplement the Resident Classification Instrument level of dependency.
