Guide For Use: This data element should always be recorded as an 8-digit valid date comprising day, month and year. Year should always be recorded in its full 4-digit format. For days and months with a numeric value of less than 10, zeros should be used to ensure that the date contains the required 8 digits. For example the date July 1 2000 should be recorded as 01072000.
Collection Methods: If the date the dwelling was vacated by tenants is not known, for example. abandonment by tenants, the date the dwelling is discovered to be vacant should be used instead.
