Code 1 Mobile

Mobile children's services carry children's services to the community. They offer a range of services including occasional care, vacation care, playgroup sessions and child care, as well as other services outside the scope of this collection.

Code 2 Non-mobile

Non Mobile should be recorded for all other childcare and preschool services. For example, a child care centre, dedicated preschool, community centre, school, home etc.

In conjunction with *Service delivery setting (children's services)* and *Suburb/town/locality name (person)*, this data element supports analyses of the range of settings in which child care and preschool services are available.
