A formal assessment, whether self-assessed or externally reviewed, should involve a number of aspects, including the planning and development of a clear structure for the assessment process, the use of an accepted evaluation method such as a peer review, and the use of validated tools where these are available.

CODE 2 Accredited

This code should only be recorded where accreditation has been granted to the organisation and is current.
