Programs may be delivered in a variety of service settings including separate preschools or kindergartens, long day care centres, in association with a primary school etc. The terms most commonly used to describe preschool services in various states and territories are:

• Kindergarten – Queensland, Western Australia, Tasmania.

• Kindergarten or Preschool – Victoria, South Australia.

• Preschool – New South Wales, Northern Territory, Australian Capital Territory.
