Scope:	These data elements are used in conjunction with each other to determine the history and current smoking status of a person.

#### **Collection and usage attributes**

Guide for use:

The Smoking status cluster comprises four data elements that, in combination, determine a person's current smoking status and history of tobacco use.

This is achieved by the combination of the four data elements: *Person—ever* smoked a full cigarette indicator, yes/no/not stated/inadequately described code N; Person—tobacco smoking start age, total years N[NN]; Person—current smoking status indicator, yes/no/not stated/inadequately described code N and Person—tobacco smoking frequency, current tobacco smoking frequency code N.

**Collection methods:** Information on a prison entrant's smoking status and history are collected at the reception assessment on the National Prisoner Health Census Prison Entrants form.

b) Do you smoke now?

c) If you smoke now, which of the following best describes your current use of tobacco?

I now smoke occasionally, but less than once a week I now smoke occasionally, not every day, but at least once a week I now smoke regularly, every day or most days.
