Computation description:	<p>This output measure is a proxy. It only captures the pathways into social housing for those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness who apply through the social housing system and does not include people who were assisted to secure and sustain private or other rental tenancies. It is determined by the following assumptions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• allocation reflects demand for social housing, not overall need for social housing• it only captures homeless people (or those at risk of homelessness) who have applied for social housing and have been allocated• that being allocated to social housing is by definition assistance to secure and sustain tenure with no requirement for length of tenure <p>Greatest need is used as a proxy for homelessness or risk of homelessness. Households in 'greatest need' are those at the time of allocation were subject to one or more of the following circumstances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• they were homeless• their life or safety was at risk in their accommodation• their health condition was aggravated by their housing• their housing was inappropriate to their needs• they had very high rental costs <p>Presented as a number.</p>
