Definition:	<p>The date of first recurrence as distant metastatic disease.</p> <p>The term recurrence defines the return, reappearance or metastasis of cancer (of the same histology) after a disease-free intermission or remission.</p> <p>Distant metastasis refers to the spread of cancer of the same histology as the original (primary) tumour to distant organs or distant lymph nodes.</p>
