<b>Definition:</b>	<p>Persons employed (or engaged via contract) on a part-time or full-time paid basis, where the person is specifically employed for the expertise developed from their experience as a mental health carer.</p> <p>Mental health carer workers include the job titles of, but not limited to, carer consultants, peer support workers, carer support workers, carer representatives and carer advocates.</p> <p>Roles that mental health carer workers may perform include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Participation in mental health service planning</li><li>• Mental health policy development</li><li>• Mental health service evaluation</li><li>• Training and education of professionals and carers</li><li>• Mentoring duties</li><li>• Advocacy roles</li><li>• Liaison activities</li><li>• Carer support roles</li></ul>
