## Identifying and definitional attributes

<b>Metadata item type:</b>	Data Element Concept
<b>METEOR identifier:</b>	462733

<b>Definition:</b>	An indicator of whether the person with cancer is being cared for under a shared care arrangement between specialists and generalist health practitioners.

<b>Object class:</b>	<a href="#">Person with cancer</a>
<b>Definition:</b>	A person who has been diagnosed with a cancer.
<b>Specialisation of:</b>	<a href="#">Person/group of persons</a>

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## Property attributes

### Identifying and definitional attributes

<b>Property:</b>	<a href="#">Shared care arrangement indicator</a>
<b>Definition:</b>	An indicator of whether shared care arrangement is in place. A shared care arrangement is an agreement between specialists/hospitals and primary health practitioners to provide care for a specific health condition. This often involves a formal agreement between practitioners which includes the planned delivery of care and information exchange above routine referral notices.
