Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use: Record the date of any immediate or short-term treatment complication that has been experienced by a patient during or after medical treatment. This includes any [adverse events](#) taking place within a specified period after treatment. The date recorded should be the earliest date that the specific treatment complication is indicated.

Multiple dates can be recorded, but only one date should be recorded per treatment complication.

Collection methods: Collect from patient medical records.
