<b>Scope:</b>	The Health service non-utilisation reason cluster defines the reason for non-utilisation of health services in the community and in prison by prison entrants in the last 12 months; and provides a greater understanding of the health seeking behaviours of prison entrants.

## Collection and usage attributes

**Guide for use:** The Health service non-utilisation reason cluster comprises three data elements that in combination provide information on a prison entrant's health seeking behaviours in the community and prison. The data elements include: [Prison entrant—service provider needed but not utilised indicator, yes/no code N](#); [Prison entrant—reason for non-utilisation of health service, code NN](#) and [Health service event—prisoner location when service provider was needed, but not utilised, prisoner location code N](#).
