<b>Scope:</b>	<p>The scope of the Non-Admitted Patient Activity and Waitlist Data Collection (NAPAAWL DC) comprises all non-admitted outpatient services in Western Australia (WA). This includes those provided at public hospitals, together with publicly-funded non-admitted outpatient services that are provided at private hospitals such as Joondalup Health Campus and Peel Health Campus.</p> <p>The NAPAAWL DC includes patient-level non-admitted activity data from the following <a href="#">core systems</a>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Open Patient Administration System (TOPAS);</li><li>• Health Care And Related Information Systems / Ambulatory, Other Patient and Domiciliary (HCARe / AOD);</li><li>• Web-based Patient Administration System (webPAS).</li></ul> <p>Although the Allied Health System (AHS) is a corporately managed system that provides patient-level non-admitted activity to the NAPAAWL DC, it does not meet the required reporting standard and therefore is not classified as a <a href="#">core system</a>.</p> <p>The addition of non-admitted outpatient data to the NAPAAWL DC from <a href="#">satellite systems</a> is currently in progress.</p>

## Collection and usage attributes

<b>Collection methods:</b>	<p>Each site provides a data extract from their own information system for inclusion in the NAPAAWL DC.</p> <p>Several hospitals use more than one of the core systems listed above.</p> <p>The data items contained in the source extracts may be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Common to all of the information systems</li><li>• Common to selected information systems</li><li>• Present in only one information system.</li></ul> <p>The NAPAAWL DC gathers all activity information at the appointment level and uses this to ascertain <a href="#">non-admitted patient service events</a>.</p>
