Metadata item type:	Glossary Item
Synonymous names:	Visits to a website
METEOR identifier:	497337
Registration status:	Health!, Standard 13/11/2014
Definition:	A series of page requests from a uniquely identified user of a website within one session. A session ends when more than 30 minutes has elapsed between each page request. Visits provide a reliable measure of overall traffic to a website.

Note that a visit can consist of one page view, or many.
