Collection and usage attributes

Guide for use: Where a person has a starting prefix to the family name, identification of that component as a prefix supports improved searching options in information systems.

Examples of a family name prefix include:

- von
- de
- ozy

Collection methods: Record alphabetic characters, punctuation (for example, '-') and spaces only.

Hyphenated family names are not a part of a name prefix and should be recorded using [Person—family name, text X\[X\(39\)\]](#).

A name prefix precedes a family name in a display of the full name. Names which include punctuation, such as O'Brien, should not have the 'O' separated out as a prefix, but should be treated as a single family name.
