CODE 7 Not applicable

Use if the child was not required to have current, documented and approved cultural support plan at 30 June in the reference period.

CODE 9 Not stated/inadequately described

Use if it is unknown whether a current, documented and approved cultural support plan was in place on the night of 30 June in the reference period.

**Collection methods:**

If the child was required to have a cultural support plan on the night of 30 June (code 1 was entered for 'cultural support plan required indicator'), code 1, 2 or 9 should be recorded for this item.

Code 9 should only be recorded if it was unknown whether a cultural support plan was in place on the night of 30 June in the reference period.

If code 2, 7 or 9 was recorded for 'cultural support plan required indicator', then code 7 should be recorded for this item.
