

Guide for use:

A respite placement is a form of out-of-home care that is used to provide short-term accommodation for children and young people where the intention is for the child to return to their prior place of residence. Respite placements include:

- Respite from birth family, where a child is placed in out-of-home care on a
 temporary basis for reasons other than child protection (e.g. the child's
 parents are ill or unable to care for them on a temporary basis; or as a family
 support mechanism to prevent entry into full time care, as part of the
 reunification process, as a shared cared arrangement).
- Respite from placement, where a child spends regular, short and agreed periods of time with another carer other than their primary carer.

Collection methods:

Code 7 'Not applicable' should be recorded if the living arrangement is not a funded out-of home care placement provided by a funded agency (e.g. living with parents, independent living, other living arrangements).
