<b>Definition:</b>	A 'carer household' is a private household containing one or more carers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• who have undergone the relevant screening/selection and approval process; and;</li><li>• who have received authorisation from the relevant department or agency to enable a child to be placed in their care, including carers who have received provisional authorisation; and</li><li>• for whom reimbursement is available from a government authority or non-government organisation for expenses incurred in caring for the child; and</li><li>• who are part of an ongoing review process.</li></ul>
