Social and emotional wellbeing is a broad concept that can be difficult to define. It incorporates mental health, but in an Indigenous context may also include issues around cultural, spiritual and social wellbeing. It encompasses not just individual wellbeing but also family and community wellbeing.</p> <p>The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander primary health-care social and emotional wellbeing services cluster describes aspects of the social and emotional wellbeing of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander primary health-care clients, during the reporting period.</p>
