

Guide for use: CODE 4 Subtotal/total

A subtotal perforation is present in the tympanic membrane: the pars tensa is absent but the perforation does not include the annulus. A total perforation is present in the tympanic membrane; the tympanic membrane is essentially absent.

CODE 9 Not stated/inadequately described

This code is used when the data is missing.
