Property:	Adverse event indicator
Definition:	An indicator of whether there is an occurrence of an adverse event. An adverse event is any harmful event befalling a patient while in the care of the health system. Such an event may be the result of professional negligence, systems failure, mistakes, fatigue or other causes.
Property group:	Illness and/or Injury event
