Temporalis fascia tissue is used for the graft.

CODE 2 Cartilage

Cartilage tissue is used for the graft.

CODE 3 Cartilage/perichondrium

Cartilage tissue and the connective tissue that surrounds the cartilage are used for the graft.

CODE 4 Fat

A piece of fat from the posterior side of the lobule is used for the graft.

CODE 5 Other

A graft type other than those separately identified.

CODE 98 Unknown

This code is used when the data is invalid.

CODE 99 Not stated/inadequately described

This code is used when the data is missing.
