Guide for use:	<p>CODE 1 Residential treatment/rehabilitation</p> <p>Refers to where residential clients receive formal rehabilitation for substance use.</p> <p>CODE 2 Residential respite</p> <p>Refers to where clients spend 1 to 7 days in residential care for respite and don't receive formal rehabilitation.</p> <p>CODE 3 Detoxification</p> <p>Refers to managed withdrawal from alcohol and/or other drugs.</p> <p>CODE 4 Sobering-up centre/program</p> <p>Refers to where clients are in residential care overnight and don't receive formal rehabilitation.</p> <p>CODE 5 Program for clients diverted from the legal system</p> <p>Refers to where courts can suspend sentence and/or release people on the condition that they attend substance abuse treatment.</p> <p>CODE 8 Advocacy</p> <p>Contact with other agencies on behalf of clients.</p> <p>CODE 9 Mobile assistance patrol/night patrol</p> <p>Local services that provide transport and care for at-risk community members, especially young people or intoxicated adults.</p>
