care.

The number of available bed-equivalents should be collected at least monthly at the same time on the same day. To improve accuracy data could be collected more frequently (e.g. daily). If so, it should be collected at the same time on each day. More frequent data collection is preferable if a single monthly count is likely to be significantly different from the monthly average.

Staffing of the unit must be consistent with other <u>admitted patient mental health</u> <u>care services</u>. Mental health hospital-in-the-home care is not a substitute for care provided by <u>residential mental health care services</u> or ambulatory mental health care services.

Collection methods: Criteria should exist to ensure that each available bed-equivalent is counted only

once.

service for an establishment.
