The Children's Global Assessment Scale (CGAS) was developed to provide a measure of severity of disturbance in children and adolescents. It is designed to reflect the lowest level of functioning for a child or an adolescent during a specified period.

The measure provides a single global rating only, on a scale of 1 to 100. Clinicians assign a score, with 1 representing the most functionally impaired child, and 100 the healthiest child.

Scale ranges:

100- 91	Superior functioning in all areas
90- 81	Good functioning in all areas
80- 71	No more than slight impairments in functioning
70- 61	Some difficulty in a single area but generally functioning pretty well
60- 51	Variable functioning with sporadic difficulties or symptoms in several but not all social areas
50- 41	Moderate interference in functioning in most social areas or severe impairment of functioning in one area
40- 31	Major impairment of functioning in several areas and unable to function in one of these areas
30- 21	Unable to function in almost all areas
20- 11	Needs considerable supervision
10-1	Needs constant supervision
