This data element is also used to derive the [mental health indicator](#). Appointments with a NHCDC Tier 2 code of 20.45 (Psychiatry), 20.50 (Psychogeriatric), 40.29 (Psychology) or 40.34 (Specialist Mental Health) will be assigned a value of Y (Yes) for the mental health indicator and will be excluded from reports of non-admitted activity.

All other NHCDC Tier 2 codes are not classified as a specialised mental health service although an appointment may still be assigned a value of Y (Yes) for the mental health indicator on the basis of the [clinic category code](#) or [NHCDC Tier 2](#)
