### **Collection and usage attributes**

Guide for use:

An individual client contact is where a client has contact with the Bringing Them Home or Link Up Counsellor for the provision of care/information. A separate contact is counted each time the client has contact with a counsellor.

Includes:

• phone contacts if they involve provision of care.

Excludes:

- Group work
- Other individuals/family members involved in family/relationship counselling unless they have their own file or record. These are counted as separate contacts.

**Collection methods:** The Bringing Them Home/Link Up Counselling Program is required to provide counts of male, female and total contacts by Indigenous status, as detailed in the Scope Bringing Them Home/Link Up Counselling Program individual client contacts table. The total contacts may include contacts for which Indigenous status or sex was not known or not reported.
