

Scope: The Community mental health care national minimum data set (CMHC NMDS) includes

data about mental health service contacts provided by specialised mental health services for patients/clients, other than those admitted to psychiatric hospitals or designated psychiatric units in acute care hospitals, and those resident in 24-hour staffed specialised

residential mental health services.

The scope covers all <u>ambulatory mental health care service</u> units that deliver clinical

care and are administered or funded by state and territory governments.

The scope of the collection includes ambulatory clinical mental health care provided by service units covering all target populations and includes general adult, child and adolescent, youth, older persons and forensic community mental health service units.

The scope excludes ambulatory equivalent same-day separations.

The scope excludes support services that are not specialised mental health care services (see <u>Specialised mental health service</u>) and services provided by non-government organisations.

The scope excludes 'in-reach' mental health service contacts, that is, service contacts provided to patients admitted to psychiatric hospitals or designated psychiatric units in acute care hospitals, and those resident in 24-hour staffed specialised residential mental health services.

Mental health data collections are hierarchical in nature. An identical reporting structure, including region name, should be common between all mental health collections, including the Mental Health Establishments (MHE), Community Mental Health Care (CMHC) and Residential Mental Health Care (RMHC) NMDSs, the Mental Health National Outcomes and Casemix Collection and any future mental health collections.

This field must not be null.

National minimum data sets:

For the provision of State and Territory hospital data to Australian Government agencies this field must:

- be less than or equal to Admission date, Date patient presents or Service contact date
- be consistent with diagnoses and procedure codes, for records to be grouped.
- Person—Indigenous status, code N
- Person-marital status, code N
- Person—person identifier, XXXXXX[X(14)]

DSS specific information:

For mental health collections, the <u>Person identifier</u> for a uniquely identifiable person should be consistent between National minimum data sets and other associated collections, and across collection periods, where technically possible.
