

patient/client by a community based service.

Involuntary patients are persons who are compulsorily treated in hospital or in the community under state and territory mental health legislation for the purpose of

assessment or provision of appropriate treatment or care.

A patient's mental health legal status may change between contacts and during an

episode of care.
