urgency category.

A patient is classified as overdue if waiting time at admission or waiting time at a census date is longer than 30 days for patients in clinical urgency category 1, 90 days for patients in clinical urgency category 2, or 365 days for patients in clinical

urgency category 3.

Comments: The number and proportion of overdue patients represent a measure of the

hospital's performance in the provision of elective hospital care.
