<b>Guide for use:</b>	<p>This value is populated using the <a href="#">Maternity Care Classification System (MaCCS)</a> and is the value of the unique model of care code.</p> <p>The model of care a female received for the majority of pregnancy care, as determined by the number of antenatal visits within that model of care.</p> <p>Where the number of antenatal visits is equal for more than one model of care, the referring model of care should be selected. For example, if a female was in a low-risk GP shared care model for 6 antenatal visits and then developed hypertension and pre-eclampsia and was referred to a high-risk model for 6 antenatal visits, the GP shared care should be selected for this data element.</p>
<b>Collection methods:</b>	To be collected once, after the birth.
